



Extract from the General Rules of the corporation "CLUB MARINA SAUREL INC." specifically relating to dock attribution and pricing

43. Dock Attribution

At the beginning of each season, the seasonal dock attribution committee for *Parc Nautique de Sorel-Tracy* and *Parc Nautique Regard-sur-le-fleuve* will determine the location for each member-lessee by applying the following criteria:

- 1 – The member has paid all fees that have been invoiced and that are payable to Marina de Saurel;
- 2 – The dock specifications (length, width between fingers, adjacent water depth);
- 3 – The boat specifications (overall length (LOA), extreme breadth (Be), draught);
- 4 – The number of seniority points.

The lessee is not allowed to change location without having obtained prior authorization from the dock committee. Such an authorization will not be considered without a written letter specifying the reason for the change in location request. Also, members are forbidden to relinquish, sublease or transfer their rights to the location, no matter what the reason or motivation is.

44. Pricing

Pricing is established according to the length of the boats and follow the prices accepted by the general assembly.

Imperial measurements will take precedence over metric measurements.

45. Measurements

45.1. The length for pricing purposes is the overall length (LOA), which is equal to the length of the hull (Lh), in accordance with Standard EN/ISO 8666 (the distance between the extreme front and rear points of the permanent structure of the boat), stretching to the boom, bulwarks, removable materials such as the anchor and davits, as well as all detachable devices that are installed when the boat is moored at the dock.

45.2. Although it is not used for docking price calculations, member-lessees must provide the midship beam measurement or the extreme breadth (Be) for their boat, which is equal to the distance between the two extreme starboard and portside points of the permanent structure of the boat.

45.3. The draught measurement, which corresponds to the vertical distance between the waterline and the lowest point of the boat, is also requested for information purposes. Because it is obviously impossible to predict variations in water levels, and irrespective of basin specifications, the Marina cannot guarantee appropriate water depths under any circumstances.

45.4. Pricing is graduated by the full foot only.

For example: 22' 05" = 22'

22' 06" = 23'
